AGE QUALIFICATIONS: Those ages 10 up to 12th grade, this fall, are welcome.

<u>DATE</u>: June 23-29, 2024. You may arrive anytime after 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 23rd. Camp ends on Saturday, June 29th, at 9:30 a.m. No noon meal will be served on Saturday.

<u>COST</u>: Cost is \$125 (Checks for the Registration fee should be made out to David Dick). We will be taking up one offering, and we will be raising funds for missions and there will also be a few concessions and things for sale. If you would like to make donations of any kind, we would appreciate it. (Checks for donations need to be separate from the registration fee and should be made out to InFaith, or Dry Creek Sunday School). Camp Scholarships are available!

<u>DONATIONS</u>: It is because so many people donate time, food, and finances that we are able to leave the price where it is. If you are writing *a check as a donation, please remember it needs to be a separate check from the registration fee.* Donations made to InFaith are tax deductible. Food donations of cookies, snacks, cheese or dessert mixes, gallon cans of vegetables and fruit, large cans of drink mix like lemonade, Tang, or hot chocolate, and fresh fruit items are all very helpful. (It takes 4 gallons of veggies/fruit for one meal)

<u>REGISTRATION</u>: Checks for registration should be made out to David Dick. (If <u>two</u> (2) friends, who are of the same age, would like to stay together, please indicate so on the bottom of the registration slip <u>and</u> make sure we have it well before camp starts.)

Since we need a parent's signature and a camper's signature on the registration slip, we will not be able to accept any registrations by phone.

<u>DRESS CODE</u>: Please dress appropriately for a Christian camp. If at any time we think you are dressed immodestly we will ask you to change. Bring conservative clothes, and the things you wear for recreation time should be modest as well. Thank You!

We will have ONE evening service designated as "dress up" night. So, bring something nice to wear for that night.

<u>TALENT NIGHT</u>: We are planning a talent night, so please bring appropriate material to share with us. Some examples could be music, drama, puppets, poetry, illusions, or object lessons.

<u>THINGS TO BRING</u>: Bible, notebook, pen, towel, and toiletries. Also, you will need a sleeping bag or bedding, and a jacket. You may also want some extra money for offering, mission fund raiser and concessions. Consider bringing lip balm, sunscreen, bug repellant, flashlight, and clothes for recreation. <u>DO NOT BRING</u>: Knives, <u>Cell phones</u>, I-pads, computers, or other electronic devices (<u>except</u> for use in talent time). Cell phones could be collected and kept by camp staff if they become a problem.
